



Dr. Sachiko Kuno is founder, President and CEO of S&R Technology Holdings, headquartered at the beautiful Evermay estate in Georgetown, DC. Its mission is to provide support to global entrepreneurs and new businesses. In addition, the S&R Foundation supports talented individuals with great potential and high

aspirations in the sciences and arts. Dr. Kuno holds a Ph.D. in industrial biochemistry from Kyoto University and has conducted post-doctoral research at the Technical University of Munich, Germany. Dr. Kuno dedicates much of her time to philanthropic activities.
